A WALK ACCROSS THE RIVER DAUGAVA

My favorite days in Riga start with "austiņas" aka "little ears" from a local bakery, "Bulkotava". Although not so little at all — they are literally face sized. They are baked fresh every day after 10 am.

Almost around the corner — "Boar BBQ" is a tiny Latvian/Georgian chefs barbeque restaurant that serves only a few dishes made from local produce. A bit pricey, but the food is fantastic. 4.9 out of 5 stars in Google is worth it!

I love to walk everywhere so I would take a stroll from the city center and cross the river Daugava to "Āgenskalns market" — the market is buzzing with local farmers and vendors. Grab a beer or excellent coffee, have a pizza, taco or Ukrainian borsch (you name it), and enjoy a concert over the weekend.

Finish the day with a movie night in a historic 1920's vintage movie theater, 'Splendid Palace' and enjoy the evening!
